Reports that shareholders in ExxonMobil, the world's largest listed oil and gas group, have backed a call for the company to publish an annual assessment of the impact of climate policies on its business despite board opposition. Some 62% of shareholders voted for a resolution filed by the Church Commissioners for England and New York State Comptroller Thomas P. DiNapoli, asking Exxon to report on how its business model will be affected by global efforts to limit the average rise in temperatures to below 2-degrees Celsius. Edward Mason, Head of Responsible Investment for the Church Commissioners, is quoted in several reports, including the BBC, FT and Guardian and by the Associated Press, Reuters and Agence France Presse news agencies.
