Reports on the fire which engulfed the 24-storey Grenfell Tower block in west London yesterday claiming the lives of 12 people - a figure expected to rise - and leaving 18 people critically ill in hospital. St Clement's Church nearby was opened in the early hours of Wednesday morning to receive evacuated residents and was collecting clothes, food and water for those affected. BBC Newsbeat and The Times quote Rev Alan Everett, Vicar of the Parish of St Clement and St James, as saying the church was providing breakfast, lunch and supper, and if necessary a place to stay overnight. The Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, who visited the community near the

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block, is guoted by the BBC as saying that the community response had been an "extraordinary sight". BBC London also carries a video interview with Archbishop Justin speaking close to the scene of the fire. The Guardian, Mirror and Christian Today quote Rev Mark O'Donoghue, Area Dean of Kensington.
