Further reports on Wednesday's vote by shareholders in ExxonMobil, the world's largest listed oil and gas group, to back a call for the company to publish an annual assessment of the impact of climate policies on its business despite board opposition. Some 62% of shareholders voted for a resolution filed by the Church Commissioners for England and New York State Comptroller Thomas P. DiNapoli, asking Exxon to report on how its business model will be affected by global efforts to limit the average rise in temperatures to below 2degrees Celsius.
